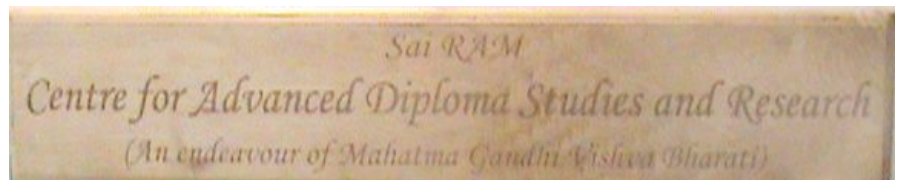
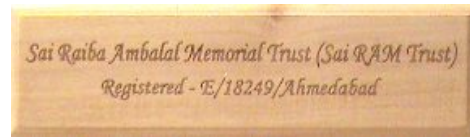

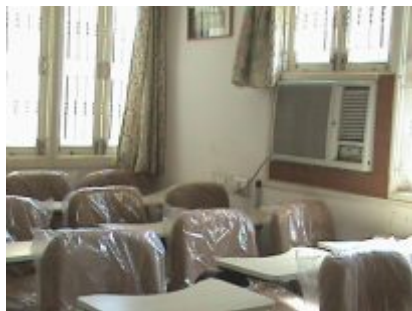
Foreword

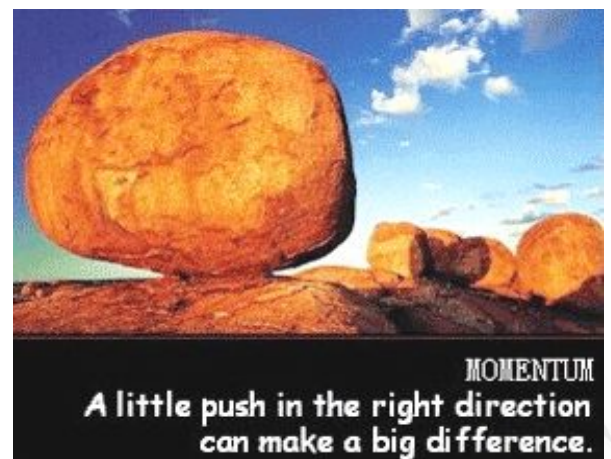
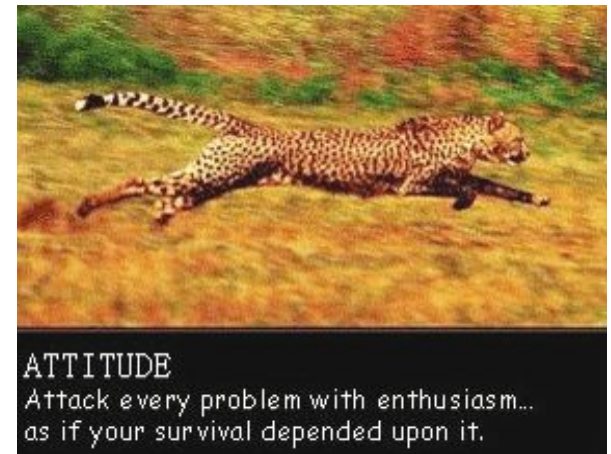
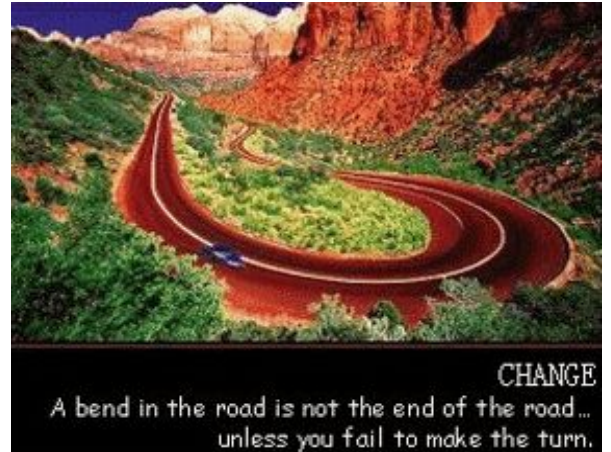
